

Are you a military family interested in receiving a cherished playhouse built with love from Habitat Volunteers? Our Playhouse Program is a unique building opportunity for teams to work together to construct and decorate children's playhouses, which are then donated to military and veteran families in Ventura County.

Who builds and paints the playhouses?

Teams of any kind can build Playhouses: corporations, faith congregations, community organizations and groups of friends. Playhouses are donated to Ventura County active duty or veteran families.

How can I receive a Habitat playhouse? Families must qualify and agree to the following:

- Must be a Ventura County active duty military or veteran family with 1 or more children under the age of 5.
- Ability to attend at the end of the "build day." You are asked to arrive with your children at a designated time.
- Interaction with volunteers who are building the playhouse.
- Pose for photos with your playhouse (sign our photo release waiver).
- **Pick up your playhouse** please make sure you have access to a truck or SUV to transport the disassembled playhouse. **Each playhouse 4 feet wide, 6 feet long, and 5 feet tall**. A truck with ropes, a large SUV, or a minivan with the rear seats removed will often do the trick but please measure first and allow enough room for everyone to be properly seat-belted in after the playhouse is loaded!
- Families reassemble the playhouse on their own instructions for easy re-assembly will be provided.
